Summary of testimony of those in favor:

02:55:41 Mr. Ashburner gave a power point presentation. The existing site is industrial but not active. It was a distillery and a tire recycling facility. The roads were never put in from Riverport Phase 5, but the road system is adequate enough to handle it and the proposed development. The landscape waiver was required because the site is adjacent to one single family home. Bohannon will need to be closed except for emergency access. The waiver to leave the drive isle is justified based on the existence of Bohannon as it exists today and would improve circulation for the entire site and

allow the northernmost building access around the middle building without going through the parking lot or truck maneuvering area.

03:00:24 Ms. Jones explained the drainage plan – how storm water will be handled and compensation on site.

03:04:25 Mr. Ashburner stated the gate will be utilized by all emergency services to be triggered in a way as to not damage the vehicles. Commissioner Carlson said it would be best to meet with the police and fire depts. and a binding element can be put in place. Mr. Ashburner agrees. This case is ready to move forward and be scheduled for a public hearing.

03:06:49 Commissioner Brown asked if sidewalks will be provided along Bohannon at the parking lot frontage. Ms. Jones said yes. What are the hours of operation and will some uses be removed from the EZ-1 list? Mr. Ashburner said there are no hours of operation because there's no specific user at this time and a list will be made to bind specific uses on each building.

03:11:37 Mr. Reverman stated, there is a Land Development Code requirement for exterior construction activity to be limited to 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.

Mr. Ashburner said he will address some of Mr. Kelly's concerns at the public hearing.
