Call to Order and Pledge of Allegiance

Council President James called the meeting to order at 6:03 p.m. and asked all to rise for the Pledge of Allegiance.

Moment of Silence

Council President James shared the sad news that Louisville Metro Police Officer Martez Hughes passed away earlier in the day while playing tennis at Chickasaw Park, and retired Louisville Metro Police Colonel Kenny Brown passed away earlier in the day after a long battle with cancer.

Council President James spoke about the 500+ percentage increase in hospitalizations due to COVID-19. He noted the number of people who have died (460) from COVID-19 as of that morning and tested positive (32,721) for COVID-19 as of the previous day in Louisville.

He asked that everyone join him in a moment of silence.

Statement Regarding Virtual Attendance by Council Members

Council President James stated that the meeting was being conducted by video teleconference, pursuant to KRS 61.826 and in accordance with Senate Bill 150.
