

Councilwoman Dorsey,

We received the quote for 3 additional cameras within Algonquin Park. Attached is the quote and map of where those cameras will be located. Also, as part of this project, LMPD is paying to replace one of the older cameras in the park, whose quality has degraded faster than others. That quote is not attached, as LMPD will cover the replacement cost.

All cameras within the park will be PTZ (pan, tilt, zoom), which allow RTCC analysts to maneuver the cameras in real time, if during an incident or during proactive monitoring. The two new cameras in the interior of the park (on the pool house and bathroom building) will also be a camera model that includes nighttime infrared abilities, which allows for much better visibility in low to no light.




