

ORDINANCE NO. 162, SERIES 2020

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 072, SERIES 2020 AND ORDINANCE NO. 073, SERIES 2020 RELATING TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021 CAPITAL AND OPERATING BUDGETS, RESPECTIVELY, BY TRANSFERRING \$700,000 FROM THE LOUISVILLE FREE PUBLIC LIBRARY OPERATING BUDGET TO THE MIDDLETOWN LIBRARY RELOCATION PROJECT FOR EXPENSES RELATED TO CONSTRUCTION AND MATERIALS (AS AMENDED).

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (THE COUNCIL) AS FOLLOWS:


SECTION II: Part I., D. Deputy Chief of Staff, of Ordinance No. 073, Series 2020, is hereby amended as follows:

 - a. General Operations



SECTION III: The Council has determined the funds requested in this Ordinance will be expended for a public purpose.


SECTION IV: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
