Thanks to you we've made great progress moving the Preston Hwy master plan (i.e. spanning Main St. to the County line) forward. As a reminder, the plan was estimated to cost 300K and the Administration allocated 150K during the budget process which we approved. Several Council members also contributed in their FY 21 budgets. As a reminder, Planning and Design created a formula to allow equitable costs sharing amongst impacted districts based on 5 categories (see chart below). After seeing your email today, I went back to double check the math on percentage breakdowns for funding by district. These percentages were calculated by averaging the 5 categories together for each district.

Shanklin (D2): 10.374% Sexton Smith (D4): 10.452%

James (D6): 3.056% Mulvihill (D10): 7.67% Fox (D13): 12.324% Triplett (D15): 5.522% George (D21): 19.296% Peden (D23): 2.65% Flood (D24): 28.656%

The differences from CW George's last email are that your portion had a calculation error (see updated % in yellow) and D15's portion was missing.

Sort of. Attached is a spreadsheet with some potential data options you all could use to determine a fair split. I used the attached map to determine the acreage data, Preston Highway and Preston Street to determine linear frontage and census blocks abutting Preston Highway and Preston Street for population and housing units. IMO, it would make the most sense to tier the percentage share based on whichever data set you all feel is most applicable (e.g. top two districts 20% each, next five districts 10% each, least two districts 5% each) or just do an even split. Feel free to give me a call if that doesn't make sense.
