BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (THE COUNCIL) AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: Part I. Revenues and Funding Sources, of Ordinance 072, Series 2020 is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION III: The sum of \$2,246,300 is hereby committed to establish a pension mitigation fund to address future pension obligations with the intentions of accessing one-third per year for the fiscal year 2022 through the fiscal year 2024 budgets.

SECTION IV: Part III, General Provisions of Ordinance No. 072, Series 2020, is hereby amended as follows:

N. Any funds remaining unappropriated as of June 30, 2021 from the \$26 million committed through Section V of Ordinance No. 156, series 2020 including any funding subsequently appropriated to Public Health & Wellness and reimbursed by the federal government, will be used first to increase the pension mitigation fund to a total of \$2.7 million.

SECTION V: The Council has determined the funds requested in this ordinance will be expended for a public purpose.

SECTION VI: The Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
