WHEREAS, Metro Government wishes to enter into this agreement with U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (THE COUNCIL) AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept \$5,430,961 of supplemental Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Securities (CARES) Act funding through the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for the Emergency Solutions Grant Program to continue efforts in supporting community needs and responding to the COVID-19 pandemic.
