
CW George,

Following from our traffic group on items 1 & 5.

Ashland Avenue is currently listed (by Ordinance) as a Metro "through" street and has a speed limit of 35 mph.. The ADT is approximately 3000 vehicles per day. It functionally classifies/operates as a local collector providing a connection between local streets and the arterial street system (Taylor and Southern Parkway). We can do a speed study and see what the 85th percentile is.. It is likely around 35 mph. And check crash rates as well.

We can/will look at Bellevue and Ashland for a multi-way stop again, but a quick look at the splits (see below) indicates that unless there is a crash problem, it would not meet MUTCD guidance for the installation of a multi-way.

Please let the CW know that TE will look at both requests. Thanks!!
