

The cost for Public Works to re-do the curb on the SW corner of Payne and Clifton and put in 2 marked crosswalks is \$37,000. It would take about 2 weeks to complete and since there isn't a good detour option, the MOT cost is the highest line item cost (\$8,750) within this cost.
