Metro Council Ad Hoc Committee on Redistricting

Council President James stated that Council Member Markus Winkler has been appointed as the Chair of the Metro Council Ad Hoc Committee on Redistricting ("Committee"), and that Council Member Piagentini has been appointed as the Vice Chair of that Committee.

Committee Member Winker stated that the Committee would have its first meeting this Wednesday [July 28, 2021] and the notice would be published shortly. He also named the other Council Members assigned to the Committee, which were:

Committee Member Winkler stated that the Committee was scheduled to meet every other Wednesday, the day before the Council meetings, at 5:00 p.m. He explained that some of the meetings would be cancelled because the Committee is waiting on the Census data that will be released around August 16, 2021. He also stated that once the data was received, some public hearings would be scheduled and later the Committee would present the proposed map to the public at meetings across the county to get feedback.

Hollie Hopkins, Jefferson County Attorney's Office, confirmed that the first meeting of the Committee would be Wednesday, July 28, 2021 at 5:00 p.m. in Council Chambers.
