SHIVELY AREA PLAN



WHAT IT IS -

The **Shively Area Plan** will be a joint planning effort led by Louisville Metro Government's Office of Advanced Planning and Sustainability, Shively City Government and Councilwoman Keisha Dorsey. The plan will utilize community engagement, existing conditions, future projections and best-practice planning strategies to create a **shared vision for the area that is implementable through plan recommendations**. The plan recommendations provide a framework for respective polices and regulations as well as opportunities for future investments in infrastructure and the built environment. Upon completion, the plan will be adopted by Louisville Metro Council and Shively City Council and its executive summary will be **adopted as an amendment to Louisville's Comprehensive Plan, Plan 2040.**

WHAT IT DOES -

The area plan will **focus on several plan components**. Land use and mobility are mandatory components per our local Neighborhood Planning ordinance (Chapter 161) and Kentucky Revised Statutes. Land use will include an analysis of existing zoning and form districts regulations, design standards and the built and natural environment along with **goals**, **objectives and recommendations for community-wide improvements**. The mobility component will analyze connectivity, accessibility and mobility in the area and provide multi-modal solutions aimed at improving safety, functionality, and connectivity. Other potential components include, but are not limited to, economic development, natural resources, place-making (public art, branding, etc.), housing and community facilities. Each component will be developed with a focus on the **CHASE (Connected, Healthy, Authentic, Sustainable, Equitable) guiding principles** that were established in Plan 2040.

WHO IS INVOLVED -

Robust community engagement is the critical foundation for the planning process. The planning process will provide opportunities for constituents to actively work with **public officials from Shively and Louisville Metro** to discuss their concerns and goals for their community. Public engagement strategies will provide a variety of means for all members of the community to formulate a vision for the area. The plan will utilize creative ways to leverage the voices and opinions of all stakeholders equitably in order to ensure the final document is indicative of the entire community. The COVID-19 pandemic will necessitate innovative solutions for engagement that will ensure the health and safety of participants.

The plan will be conducted by a **multi-disciplinary team of planning and design consultants** and project managed by staff from Louisville Metro and the City of Shively.

PREVIOUS PLANS -

The City of Shively has recently completed other planning processes that this plan will be able to build upon. The **Shively Town Center Plan**, created in 2019, was a community-driven process that established design guidelines and redevelopment strategies focused on the area around Crums Lane, Dixie Highway and 7th Street Road. The town center plan encourages a unified development pattern that accentuates land uses around this critical intersection by introducing increased density and design standards that complement the new **Dixie Bus-Rapid-Transit (BRT) system**. The Shively Town Center Plan will be adopted as an appendix to the Shively Area Plan and establish specific concepts that maximize the potential of this area.

The **Dixie Highway Access Study** (2020) is an access and mobility compliment to the **Dixie Highway Corridor Master Plan** (2013), which set the stage for the Dixie BRT line. The access study recommends connections for various modes of travel (walking, biking, driving, etc.) from the neighborhoods adjacent to the Dixie corridor along Crums Lane and Gagel Avenue. This study will serve as the basis for an expanded analysis of mobility solutions that creates safe connections to the Dixie BRT system and the neighborhood services located in the area.

WHAT WILL IT COST -

The **estimated cost of the plan is \$75,000** that will be split equally between Louisville Metro, Shively and Councilwoman Keisha Dorsey. The consulting firm will be selected by a committee of local stakeholders and government officials through a Request for Proposals (RFP) that will be released in early 2021.

Based on this, I think the only thing that might need to be done right now is an ordinance appropriating the \$25k over to Develop Louisville in connection with the plan, if that hasn't been done already. Under LMCO 161.02, the plan process itself can start either by Develop Louisville, or essentially a letter/written request to Develop Louisville. An ordinance/resolution is not required to initiate. Based on the first attachment to your email, it appears the plan process has been initiated.

The real drafting occurs once the Planning Commission holds the public hearing on the actual plan and executive summary. At that point, I'd draft the ordinance with the Planning Commission's recommendation to Metro Council on the plan and executive summary. Hope that helps!
