


























Nature Play Space

There is currently no playground or public park in the Parkland neighborhood; Center For Neighborhoods is collaborating with neighbors and local business owners to address this gap so that the kids of parkland have a safe place to play.

Prioritizing natural materials over traditional plastic and metal, this play space will give neighbors an outlet for outdoor play and introduce a unique sensory opportunity to the neighborhood. Vertical climbing elements like climbing poles, tree trunks, large boulders and climbing stumps of different heights offer the freedom of unstructured play and introduce healthy risk through physical challenge. Other play elements like a tunnel, a hidden "nature trail", and a fort made of natural materials create secret hideaway elements that add an air of whimsy to this play space. Flowering shrubs, bright wildflowers, fragrant herbs and a variety of groundscaping materials will ignite the senses of Parkland neighbors, while the strategic use of vibrant colors will serve as an indicator to passersby that this space is constructed just for the kids of Parkland.
