**WHEREAS,** the portion of the Executive Order addressing emergency procurement measures has expired.

\$200,000.00 for a new not-to-exceed amount of \$650,000.00 for an amendment to the noncompetitively negotiated Professional Service Contract with Vitality DX, LLC for COVID-19 testing from January 15, 2021 through December 31, 2021.
