## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT ("THE COUNCIL") AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The sum of $\$ 45,112.20$ is hereby appropriated from District 3 Neighborhood Development Funds to Public Works to increase the lighting in District 3 providing more security for constituents in those areas.
