AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FOLLOWING SECTIONS OF THE LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE AS PART OF A CONTINUING EFFORT TO UPDATE THE ZONING REGULATIONS FOR LOUISVILLE METRO: 5.1.12, 4.1.2, 5.2.2.C, 5.2.3.D.3, 5.2.4.C.3, 5.2.5.C.3, 5.2.6.E, 5.3.1.C, 5.4.1, AND 5.4.2 (CASE NO. 14AMEND1003)(AS AMENDED).

A motion was made by Chair Person Peden, seconded by Council Member Stuckel, that the Ordinance be amended on Page 4 under Subsection B.1 from "200" to "500". The motion to amend carried by a voice vote.

A motion was made by Chair Person Peden, seconded by Council Member Hamilton, that the Ordinance be amended by replacing Subsection d. on Page 5 with the following: "Building Height – The building height shall fall within the range of building heights of existing structures within the same block face. In cases where the maximum building height allowed within the applicable form district is greater than the established range within a block face, the maximum building height within the range may be exceeded by up to 25%, but may not exceed the maximum building height allowed within the particular form district. The proposed building height may also be as much as 25% lower than the minimum building height of the established range within the block face." The motion to amend failed by a voice vote.

A motion was made by Chair Person Peden, seconded by Council Member Stuckel, that the Ordinance be amended on Page 6 under Subsection 3 from "200" to "500". The motion to amend carried by a voice vote.
