- Metro Public Works has approximately 1000 extra recycle carts
- Questions and concerns about whether the old recycle carts can continue to be used
- The new recycle carts will all have blue lids
- Questions and concerns about what would happen if your recycle cart is stolen
- If a recycle cart is stolen it is the constituent's responsibility to replace the cart
- Metro Public Works will be saving money in overtime by making pick-ups bi-weekly
- Metro Public Works will not do any winter suspension with the new pick-up system
