- Questions and concerns about what would happen if your recycle cart is stolen
- If a recycle cart is stolen it is the constiuent's responsibility to replace the cart
- Metro Public Works will be saving money in overtime by making pick-ups bi-weekly
- Metro Public Works will not do any winter suspension with the new pick-up system
