WHEREAS, Louisville Metro and the surrounding communities have demonstrated strong and longstanding support for the sport of basketball; and

WHEREAS, Louisville Metro has the facilities to accommodate a National Basketball Association ("NBA") team; and

WHEREAS, the Yum! Center represents one of the best arenas in the country; and

WHEREAS, the recently approved collective bargaining agreement for the National Basketball Association ("NBA") opens the opportunity for NBA expansion teams; and
