FOR OPERATING EXPENSE, PROGRAM EXPENSES ASSOCIATED WITH PAPER, PRINTING & POETRY: BOOK ARTS BIND A COMMUNITY TO ITS FUTURE, AND CAPITAL EXPENDITURES. (AS AMENDED).

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (THE COUNCIL) AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The amount sum of \$4019,000 is hereby appropriated from District 5 Neighborhood Development Funds in the following manner: \$18,500 from District 5; and \$250 each from Districts 16 and 17;; through the Office of Management and Budget, to Portland Museum, Inc. for operating expenses, program expenses associated with Paper, Printing & Poetry: Book Arts Bind a Community to its Future, and capital expenditures.
