BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (THE COUNCIL) AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The sum of ~~\$9,750~~ \$13,750 is hereby appropriated from Neighborhood Development Funds in the following manner: \$3,000 from District 25; \$2,500 from District 14; \$1,000 each from Districts 4, 12, 13, 15, 21 and 24; \$500 each from Districts 2, 7, 22 and 26, \$250 from District 10,
