AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$17,213.37 FROM NEIGHBORHOOD DEVELOPMENT FUNDS IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER: \$6,713.37 FROM DISTRICT 25; \$3,500 FROM DISTRICT 14; \$3,000 EACH FROM DISTRICTS 12, 13; \$500 FROM DISTRICT 15; AND \$250 EACH FROM DISTRICTS 10, 21; THROUGH THE OFFICE OF MANAGEMENT AND BUDGET, TO PRAIRIE VILLAGE BASEBALL-SOFTBALL, INC. FOR RENOVATION OF ITS T-BALL FIELD

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (THE COUNCIL) AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The sum of \$17,213.37 is hereby appropriated from Neighborhood Development Funds in the following manner: \$6,713.37 from District 25; \$3,500 from District 14; \$3,000 each from Districts 12, 13; \$500 from District 15; and \$250 each from Districts 10, 21; through the Office of Management and Budget, to Prairie Village Baseball-Softball, Inc. for renovation of its T-ball Field.

SECTION II: The Council has determined the funds requested in this Ordinance will be expended for a public purpose.
