FOR COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE SOLAR OVER LOUISVILLE EDUCATIONAL CAMPAIGN.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (THE COUNCIL) AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The sum of \$7,372 is hereby appropriated from Neighborhood Development Funds, in the following manner: \$1,468 each from Districts 9, 12, 8, 13; \$500 from Districts 21, 25; \$250 from Districts 1, 6, through the Office of Management and Budget, to the Louisville Sustainability Council, Inc. for costs associated with the Solar Over Louisville Educational Campaign.

SECTION II: The Council has determined the funds requested in this Ordinance will be expended for a public purpose.

SECTION III: This grant is subject to the Council's Policies and Procedures as adopted and effective at the date of passage of this Ordinance.

SECTION IV: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
