BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT ("THE COUNCIL") AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION I:** Ordinance No. 053, Series 2020 is hereby amended and appropriates \$13,000 \$17,000 \$18,000 from Neighborhood Development Funds in the following manner: \$2,000 from District 4; \$1,500 each from Districts 3 and 25; \$1,000 each from Districts 1, 2, 6, 8, 9, 10, 15, 20, and 24 <del>and</del> <del>25</del>; <del>and</del> \$500 each from Districts 12, 13, 14, 19, 21, <del>and</del> 23, and 26; and \$250 each from Districts 17 and 22; through the Office of Management and Budget, to the Waterfront Development Corporation for the Second Annual Juneteenth Jubilee in Waterfront Park which due to COVID-19 will be a video series of seven 15-minute educational segments featuring professional actors from Actor's Theater, narration, local artists and work by local performing arts organizations. The series will be released on various platforms, including social media, YouTube, and Actor's Theater's digital streaming service. SECTION II: The Council has determined the funds requested in this Ordinance will be expended for a public purpose. **SECTION III:** This grant is subject to the Council's Policies and Procedures as adopted and effective at the date of passage of this Ordinance. **SCTION IV:** This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
