AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 102, SERIES 2014, RELATING TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2014-15 OPERATING BUDGET FOR THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT, BY TRANSFERRING \$7,600 OF GENERAL FUND FROM ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT TO PUBLIC HEALTH AND WELLNESS DEPARTMENT.

Be it ordained by the Legislative Council of the Louisville/Jefferson County Metro Government (The Council) As Follows:

SECTION I: Part I., F., 2. Develop Louisville, of Ordinance No. 102, Series 2014, is hereby amended

as follows:

- 2. DEVELOP LOUISVILLE
 - a. General Operations

(1) General Fund	9,179,300 <u>9,171,700</u>
(2) Community Development	2,884,800
(5) Agency and Other Receipts	<u>4,829,500</u>

Total- Economic Development16,893,60016,886,000The reduction of \$7,600 above listed in Item 1.a. (1) removes the funding associated with the WestLouisville Youth Space (Adventures in Theatre Camp program) from the Arts, Cultural Assets, andParks Fund administered by Economic Development.

SECTION II: Part I., E., 3. Public Health & Wellness, of Ordinance No. 102, Series 2014, is hereby amended as follows:

- 1. Public Health & Wellness
 - a. General Operations
 - (1) General Fund <u>13,877,900</u> <u>13,885,500</u>
 - (2) Design'd Other Fund Bal. 15,000
 - (3) Agency and Other Receipts <u>1,064,200</u>
 - Total-Public Health & Wellness 26,484,300 26,491,900

The increase of \$7,600 above listed in Item 1.a. (1) increases the funding for Family Health Center as

it relates to that entity's new facility.

SECTION III: The Council has determined the funds requested in this ordinance will be expended for a public purpose.

SECTION IV: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
