TO EXECUTE ANY DOCUMENTS FACILITATE WHICH ARE DEEMED NECESSARY BY KOHS TO AND ADMINISTER TO AS THE AUTHORIZED THE PROJECT AND ACT CORRESPONDENT FOR THE PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Jefferson County Sheriff has the authority and desires to make an application

for grant funds through the KOHS for a project to obtain protective safety vests; and

WHEREAS, the KOHS has requested a duly adopted resolution of the Louisville/Jefferson

County Metro Council ("Metro Council") recognizing and approving the Jefferson County Sheriff's

authority to make application for and receive the necessary funds for the above described project; and

WHEREAS, even though the Jefferson County Sheriff annually submits the budget for said office to the Metro Council for its approval, the Metro Council acknowledges that the application and receipt of these funds, as well as the execution of any agreement pursuant to the above described KOHS project, will not have any budgetary implications which would require additional Metro Council review and approval; and

WHEREAS, the Jefferson County Sheriff intends, if necessary, to expend monies as matching funds from reserves in his office's aforementioned operating budget approved by the Metro Council in order to obtain grant funds for the project; and

WHEREAS, the Metro Council recognizes that an application for and approval of KOHS funds may impose certain obligations and responsibilities upon the Jefferson County Sheriff but said constitutional office has the independent lawful authority to make application for and to enter into any agreement required by KOHS to facilitate the above described project and act as its own authorized correspondent for said project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. The Metro Council recognizes and approves the authority of the Jefferson County Sheriff to execute and furnish all required documentation, including any necessary contract or memorandum of agreement, as may be required by KOHS for the furtherance of the abovereferenced project for protective safety vests and to act as the authorized correspondent for said project.

SECTION II. This Resolution shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
