OR RESOLUTION **DETERMINING PORTIONS** OF ALL EIGHT STREETS BOUNDING **EXPOSITION** THE **KENTUCKY FAIR** AND CENTER SHOWN **HERETO** ATTACHED OWNED BY THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON **METRO** GOVERNMENT ("METRO GOVERNMENT") **SUCCESSOR** COUNTY THE CITY OF LOUISVILLE, AS SURPLUS AND NO LONGER NEEDED FOR A GOVERNMENT SAID **PURPOSE** AND **AUTHORIZING STREETS** BE TRANSFERRED TO THE COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY.

WHEREAS, according to KRS 67C.101, Metro Government, successor the City of Louisville, may enact resolutions for the municipal purpose of sale or conveyance of real property owned by Metro Government; and

WHEREAS, Section 1(A) of Executive Order No. 2, Series 2011, of the Metro Mayor, which adopts Section 2(C) of Executive Order No. 3, Series 2007 provides that Metro Government may sell

and convey surplus real estate upon a determination by the Legislative Council of Metro Government ("the Council") that such property is no longer needed for the governmental purposed of Metro Government; and

WHEREAS, the Jefferson County Road Engineer, Jeffrey Brown, has declared and certified to the Council that the real property, which is the subject of this Resolution, is surplus to the needs of Metro Government; and

WHEREAS it is in the best interests of Metro Government and the Commonwealth of Kentucky that the real property which is the subject of this Resolution be transferred to the Commonwealth of Kentucky and that the Commonwealth of Kentucky be responsible for the maintenance of said property; and

WHEREAS, Jeffrey Brown, the County Road Engineer for Louisville Metro, has determined that the real property which is the subject of this Resolution be detached from the Louisville Metro Road System and be transferred to the Commonwealth of Kentucky (see Exhibit B attached hereto).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The Council determines that the real property described in Exhibit A hereto is no longer needed to carry out the governmental functions of Metro Government.

SECTION II: That the properties named herein be detached from the Louisville/Jefferson County Metro Road System and the County Road Engineer shall amend the map of said road system to reflect these detachments.

SECTION III: That the Mayor is hereby authorized to transfer the properties named herein, in the manner provided according to Section 2 of Executive Order No. 3 Series 2007, to the Commonwealth of Kentucky, for the Commonwealth of Kentucky to take over the maintenance of the properties named herein without further action by the Council.

SECTION IV: This Resolution shall become effective upon its passage and approval.
