WHEREAS, the City of Louisville previously entered into a Lease Agreement with Option to

Purchase dated December 12, 2001 with Thomas P. Burkhart (the "Original Lease") to lease property

owned by Mr. Burkhart at 148 North Clay Street (the "Property"), pursuant to which the Property was

to be used as part of David Armstrong Extreme Park; and

WHEREAS, Louisville/Jefferson County Metro Government ("Louisville Metro") is the

successor to the City of Louisville under the Original Lease; and

WHEREAS, the Property has been used as part of David Armstrong Extreme Park during the

term of the Original Lease; and

WHEREAS, the Original Lease, by its terms, expired November 14, 2021, and Louisville Metro

in the process of entering into a new ground lease and option agreement with Thomas P. Burkhart, Trustee of the Clare E. Burkhart Living Trust, u/a July 17, 2008, for the continued lease of the Property for use as part of David Armstrong Extreme Park (the "New Lease); and

WHEREAS, a copy of the proposed New Lease is attached to this Resolution as Exhibit A; and

**WHEREAS**, the New Lease contemplates another twenty (20) year term, unless sooner terminated or extended; and

**WHEREAS,** Section 17 of the New Lease states that the New Lease is contingent upon approval by the Legislative Council of the Louisville/Jefferson County Metro Government; and

WHEREAS, Louisville Metro will receive benefits from the continued operation of David Armstrong Extreme Park.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION I:** The proposed New Lease in substantially the form and with the contents set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference is hereby approved, and the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver said New Lease.

**SECTION II:** This Resolution shall become effective upon its passage and approval or otherwise becoming law.
