adequately buffer adjacent development; and
WHEREAS greater perimeter landscape buffers will protect existing development and make

new development more compatible.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The Planning Commission shall undertake a review of the current Land Development Code and adopt amendments thereto to increase the requirements to preserve tree canopy, specifically any existing perimeter tree masses to a depth not to exceed 30 feet where proposed commercial and residential development are adjacent to existing residential development.

SECTION II: This Resolution shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
