ORDINANCE NO. _____, SERIES 2015
AN ORDINANCE CLOSING CHAMBERLAIN LANE FROM MINT SPRING BRANCH ROAD EAST TO BROWNSBORO ROAD AND BEING IN LOUISVILLE METRO (CASE NO. 15STREETS1015).
SPONSORED BY: COUNCILWOMAN MADONNA FLOOD

WHEREAS, the Louisville Metro Planning Commission, as set forth in its minutes and records of Case No. 15STREETS1015, has recommended to the Legislative Council of the Louisville/Jefferson County Metro Government (the "Council") that closing Chamberlain Lane from Mint Spring Branch Road east to Brownsboro Road and being in Louisville Metro be approved since the closed roadway will be used to accommodate new roadway and infrastructure improvements for the expansion of the North Village of Norton Commons; and

WHEREAS, the Council concurs in and adopts the findings of the Planning Commission in Case No. 15STREETS1015 and approves and accepts the recommendations of the Planning Commission as set out in said minutes and records;

Now therefore be it ordained by the Legislative Council of the Louisville/Jefferson

County Metro Government as follows:

Section I: That Chamberlain Lane from Mint Spring Branch Road east to Brownsboro Road and being in Louisville Metro as more particularly described in the minutes and records of the Planning Commission in Case No. 15STREETS1015 and as shown on the attached plat be closed, subject to all existing easements of record and all existing utility easements or rights enjoyed by said utility companies as the result of being located in, on or over said right-of-way.

Section II: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
