WHEREAS, the Legislative Council of the Louisville/Jefferson County Metro Government (the "Council") passed Ordinance No. 63, Series 2017 on April 13, 2017;

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 63, Series 2017 imposes a moratorium on the development of land within a certain area on Lexington Road pending a land use study of this area; and

WHEREAS, the Council wishes to assist in the costs associated with conducting this land use study;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (THE COUNCIL) AS FOLLOWS:
