**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (THE COUNCIL) AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION I:** The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept funding from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Office of Minority Health Resource Center in the amount of \$2,500 to create community awareness of infant mortality in Louisville Metro and to organize a Baby Buggy Walk in the Park to take place on September 13, 2014, to be administered by the Department of Public Health and Wellness.
