AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 102, SERIES 2016 RELATING TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2016-17 CAPITAL BUDGET BY APPROPRIATING \$425,000 TO EMERGENCY SERVICES' EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY RELATED TO RELOCATION AND PURCHASE OF EQUIPMENT ASSOCIATED WITH 1300 AND 1306 BARDSTOWN ROAD.**

Be it ordained by the Legislative Council of the Louisville/Jefferson County Metro Government (The Council) As Follows:

SECTION I: Part I., APPROPRIATIONS/AUTHORIZATIONS, A. REVENUES AND FUNDING SOURCES, of Ordinance No. 102, Series 2016, is hereby amended as follows:
