RESOLUTION NO. _____, SERIES 2014 A RESOLUTION HONORING THE LIFE OF COLONEL MICHAEL HETTICH.

WHEREAS, Colonel Hettich was a staunch supporter of the men and women in law enforcement; and

WHEREAS, Colonel Hettich was a devoted family man to his wife, Tandeta and children, Dakota and Heather; and

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (THE COUNCIL) AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The Metro Council hereby adopts this Resolution Honoring the Life of Colonel Mike Hettich and urges the citizens of Metro Louisville to take notice.

SECTION II: This Resolution shall take effect upon its passage and approval.

SECTION III: Due to the timing of Colonel Hettich's recent passing, the Council deems the passage of this

Resolution an emergency and therefore, pursuant to Rule 7.12, suspends Rule 7.01 and requests its immediate approval.
