**RESOLUTION NO. \_\_\_\_\_, SERIES 2015**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACCEPT A GRANT OF \$112,200 FROM THE KENTUCKY OFFICE OF HOMELAND SECURITY (“KOHS”) TO BE ADMINISTERED BY EMERGENCY SERVICES’ EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the Kentucky Office of Homeland Security (KOHS) has selected Louisville Metro Government to receive a grant intended to provide video display and projection equipment for the Emergency Operations Center (EOC) to upgrade current communications capabilities. KOHS will provide a grant of \$112,200 for this purpose; and

**WHEREAS**, the KOHS and Metro Government will agree on a scope of work for the use of these funds, which must be expended for the agreed-upon equipment purchase and installation; and

**WHEREAS**, Metro Government wishes to accept this money.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (“THE COUNCIL”) AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION I:** The Mayor is authorized to accept an \$112,200 grant from the KOHS to improve its current communications capabilities in the EOC.

**SECTION II:** This Resolution shall become effective upon its passage and approval.
