**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACCEPT \$45,000 OF FUNDING FROM THE INDIANA DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY (IDHS) FOR COMPLEX COORDINATED TERRORIST ATTACKS (CCTA) PREPAREDNESS, PREVENTION, AND RESPONSE TO BE ADMINISTERED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF EMERGENCY SERVICES.**
