**Title:** AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING [\$14,000] \$40,000 FROM NEIGHBORHOOD DEVELOPMENT FUNDS IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER: \$10,000 FROM DISTRICT 1 [NEIGHBORHOOD DEVELOPMENT FUNDS]; \$5,000 FROM DISTRICT 26; \$3,000 FROM DISTRICT 24; \$2,500 FROM DISTRICT 17; \$2,000 FROM DISTRICT 19; \$1,500 FROM DISTRICT 14; AND \$1,000 EACH FROM DISTRICTS 2, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 12, 13, [AND] 15, 16, 18, 20, 21, 22, 23, AND 25; TO LOUISVILLE METRO POLICE DEPARTMENT TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE VICTIM SERVICES UNIT WHICH PROVIDES EMERGENCY SHELTER AND RELOCATION ASSISTANCE TO A CRIME VICTIM OR WITNESS (AS AMENDED).
