**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACCEPT THE VICTIMS OF CRIME ACT GRANT FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$50,000 FOR TRAINING AND OPERATING EXPENSES WITHIN THE VICTIM SERVICES UNIT TO BE ADMINISTERED BY THE LOUISVILLE METRO POLICE DEPARTMENT.**

**WHEREAS**, Metro Government was selected by the United States Department of Justice to receive the funds for the purpose of training and operating expenses within the Victim Services Unit,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (“THE COUNCIL”) AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION I:** The Mayor is authorized to accept a \$50,000 grant from the United States Department of Justice to be used for training and operating expenses within the Victim Services Unit.

**SECTION II:** This Resolution shall become effective upon its passage and approval.
