**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACCEPT \$602,261 OF FUNDING FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY THROUGH THE PORT SECURITY GRANT PROGRAM FOR THE ACQUISITION OF PUBLIC PROTECTION EQUIPMENT TO BE ADMINISTERED BY THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE COMMISSION.**
