**Be it ordained by the Legislative Council of the Louisville/Jefferson County Metro Government (The Council) As Follows:**

**SECTION I:** Part I. A. Public Works & Assets of Ordinance No. 94, Series 2004 as amended by Resolution No. 118, Series 2007 is hereby amended as follows:

**SECTION II:** Louisville Metro Government and Commonwealth of Kentucky Transportation Cabinet both wish to enter into an agreement to move forward with the supplemental agreement for Cooper Chapel Phase III as listed in Section I of this Ordinance.
