WHEREAS, the Metro Government wishes to enter into this agreement through the Metro Parks Department.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (THE COUNCIL) AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the Commonwealth of Kentucky Transportation Cabinet to accept additional funding of \$336,000 for the continuation of the design phase for the Louisville Loop Middletown-Eastwood Trail Bicycle and Pedestrian facilities that includes a shared-use path along US 60 from Beckley Station Woods Drive to Eastwood Cut-off.
