WHEREAS, the Louisville/Jefferson County Metro Government, by and through its Metro Parks & Recreation Department, wishes to enter into this agreement.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (THE COUNCIL) AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the United States Department of Interior, Fish and Wildlife Service, to accept funding of \$30,000 for the Salt River Conservancy Project to gather data and map important conservation features in the lower Salt River watershed.

SECTION II: This Resolution shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
