BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (THE COUNCIL) AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: Part I., A. Mayor's Office/Louisville Metro Council, 2. Louisville Metro Council, of Ordinance No. 101, Series 2016, is hereby amended as follows:

2. LOUISVILLE METRO COUNCIL

- a. General Operations General Fund ~~5,433,100~~ 5,440,900
- b. Neighborhood Development Fund General Fund ~~2,759,600~~ 2,751,800

SECTION II: The Council has determined the funds requested in this Ordinance will be expended for a public purpose.
