A RESOLUTION RELATING TO IMMUNITY FROM LIABILITY FOR DAMAGING A VEHICLE TO REMOVE AN ANIMAL.

**WHEREAS**, the Legislative Council of the Louisville/Jefferson County Metro Government ("the Council") believes that a domestic animal, as defined in KRS 446.010, should not be left unattended in a hot vehicle;

**WHEREAS**, the Council believes that the "Look Before You Lock Act" statute in KRS 411.245 should apply to situations involving pets.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT ("THE COUNCIL") AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION I:** The Council urges the Kentucky State Legislature to extend the "Look Before You Lock Act" statute in KRS 411.245 to apply to situations involving pets left unattended in hot vehicles.
