BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (THE COUNCIL) AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The sum of \$11,150 \$11,900 \$13,613.44 is hereby appropriated from Neighborhood Development Funds in the following manner: \$4,000 \$1,463.44 from District 3; \$2,000 each from Districts 20 and 21; \$1,000 from District 25; \$750 from District 6; \$500 each from Districts 2, 4, 7, 10, 16, 23, and 24, and 26; \$350 from District 1; \$300 from District 5; \$250 each from Districts 9, 12, 13, 14, and 15, 17, and 18; through the Office of Management and Budget, to United Nations Association of the United States of America Kentucky Division, Ltd. for expenses associated with conducting the Human Trafficking & Intersectional Exploitations Conference held at the University of Louisville.

**SECTION II:** The Council has determined the funds requested in this Ordinance will be expended for a public purpose.

**SECTION III:** This grant is subject to the Council's Policies and Procedures as adopted and effective at the date of passage of this Ordinance.

This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
