A RESOLUTION HONORING COACH BILL MILLER BY DEDICATING GREENWOOD ROAD FROM FEYHURST DRIVE TO WALLER LANE TO BE NAMED "COACH BILL MILLER WAY" IN HIS HONOR

WHEREAS, Coach Bill Miller provided exceptional leadership to the community of Pleasure Ridge Park High School;

WHEREAS, Coach Miller was born at the old apple orchard "Miller's Curve" on Cane Run Road to George and Virginia Miller;

WHEREAS, Coach Miller attended PRP High School graduating in 1967 and then the University of Alabama playing football for Bear Bryant and baseball;

WHEREAS, Coach Miller returned to PRP High School after college as a teacher and coached the school's freshman and junior-varsity baseball teams. He became head coach in 1980;

WHEREAS, Coach Miller led the PRP Panthers to six state championships in 1994, 1995, 1996, 2008, 2013 and 2017; and posted a state-record 1,144 victories during his 39 year career as the
