AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING ~~\$7,000~~ \$18,200 FROM DISTRICT 22 IN NEIGHBORHOOD DEVELOPMENT FUNDS, IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER: \$11,200 FROM DISTRICT 21 AND \$7,000 FROM DISTRICT 22; THROUGH THE OFFICE OF MANAGEMENT AND BUDGET, TO CHILDREN HAVE OPTIONS IN CHOOSING EXPERIENCES, INC. (C.H.O.I.C.E., INC.), FOR THE "DARE TO DREAM" SPORTS LEADERSHIP AND MENTORING PROGRAM (AS AMENDED).

SPONSORED BY: COUNCIL MEMBERS ENGEL AND LANSHIMA

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT (THE COUNCIL) AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The sum of ~~\$7,000~~ \$18,200 is hereby appropriated from ~~District 22~~ Neighborhood Development Funds, in the following manner: \$11,200 from District 21 and \$7,000 from District 22; through the Office of Management and Budget, to C.H.O.I.C.E., Inc., for the "Dare to Dream" sports leadership and mentoring program.

SECTION II: The Council has determined that the funds requested in this Ordinance will be expended for a public purpose.

SECTION III: This grant is subject to the Council's Policies and Procedures as adopted and effective at the date of passage of this Ordinance.

SECTION IV: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
