**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 32 OF THE LOUISVILLE METRO CODE OF ORDINANCES ("LMCO") TO COMPLY WITH FEDERAL LAW REGARDING METRO EMPLOYEES AND CONTRACTORS WITH ACCESS TO FEDERAL TAX INFORMATION.**

**WHEREAS**, Louisville Metro amends the Louisville Metro Code of Ordinances ("LMCO") § 32.450(J) to comply with federal law regarding Louisville Metro Government employees and contractors with access to or use of federal tax information.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION I:** The Council hereby amends LMCO § 32.450(J) with the following language:

(J) The employees of the Revenue Commission shall be governed by personnel ordinances, policies, and procedures as are in effect for other Metro Government departments, agencies, and offices in accordance with § 35.001. In addition, employees of the Revenue Commission, including

contract staff, with access to or use of federal tax information shall submit to a background investigation in compliance with 26 U.S.C. § 6103(p)(4) and the Revenue Commission shall promulgate a Background Investigation Policy to implement this subsection.

**SECTION II:** This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
