RESOLUTION **AUTHORIZING** THE **MAYOR** ON **BEHALF** OF **METRO** GOVERNMENT CONVEYING TO SIGN EIGHT DEEDS AND RELEASING CONSERVATION EASEMENTS NOW HELD BY METRO GOVERNMENT ON EIGHT TRACTS OWNED BY THE COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY WHICH MUST BE INCLUDED IN THE RIGHT OF WAY FOR THE WIDENING OF RIVER ROAD IN JEFFERSON COUNTY.

WHEREAS, Metro Government and the Commonwealth of Kentucky for the use and benefit of the Transportation Cabinet (the "Cabinet") contracted in 2013 to widen River Road in Jefferson County from two lanes to four lanes from east of Beargrass Creek to west of Zorn Avenue as shown on the attached copy of a part of the Cabinet's Right of Way Plans; and

WHEREAS, the Cabinet is now acquiring the necessary right of way for such widening and to convey that land area to Metro Government free and clear of any liens, taxes or encumbrances; and
