**SECTION I:** The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the Commonwealth of Kentucky Transportation Cabinet to accept additional funding of \$125,408 for the continuation of the Louisville Loop Multi-Use Path Project by extending the project end date to June 30, 2020.
