# NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE LOUISVILLE/JEFFERSON COUNTY METRO GOVERNMENT AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION I:** That the unimproved right-of-way between Cooper Church Drive and Preston Highway and being in Louisville Metro as more particularly described in the minutes and records of the Planning Commission in Case No. 19-STRCLOSURE-0013 and as shown on the attached road closure plat be closed, subject to all existing easements of record and all existing utility easements or rights enjoyed by said utility companies as the result of being located in, on or over said right-of-way.

**SECTION II:** This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
